

The USCIS New Fees

A Quick Update from uscitizenpod

Here is a quick update on the new USCIS fees. The fee increase begins **July 30, 2007**. That means that your forms must be postmarked no later than July 29, 2007 11:59pm to take advantage of the lower fees.
